
Methodology


- Online survey of N=500 Oregonians ages 18+
- Conducted August 31–September 5, 2021
- Quotas and statistical weighting by gender, age, education, race, area of the state and political affiliation to match Oregon's general population
- Margin of error ±4.4%
- Due to rounding, some totals may differ by ±1 from the sum of separate responses

How important do you think COVID-19 vaccination is to stopping the spread of infection in your community?






Do you support or oppose the State of Oregon requiring the following people to be vaccinated against COVID-19?

Strongly support / Somewhat support / Somewhat oppose / Strongly oppose / Don't know




Support for vaccine requirements by party



Governor Brown has mandated that all public school and healthcare workers take the COVID-19 vaccine. Some communities, particularly in rural Oregon, oppose the mandate because many local teachers and healthcare workers say they will quit their jobs rather than take the vaccine. These communities fear that schools and healthcare facilities will close if these workers follow through and quit their jobs.

Knowing this, do you support or oppose Governor Brown's mandate that all public school and healthcare workers take the COVID-19 vaccine?






Has the United State's government response to the September 11th attacks made the country...







Looking back, do you think that the United States made the right decision or wrong decision in using military force in Afghanistan?
